Drivers from across America and Canada will compete in a 40-lap main event with a top prize of \$3,000.00. Drivers expected to attend include 2017 KOTW Rookie of the YearJason Conn, Prince George British Columbia Canada. SJ Racing will bring 2 drivers, Johhny Giesler, Meridian ID & Adian Spiers, Adrian,OR, AJ Russell, and Austin Carter will travel out of Clovis, CA. Tom Paterson & Jim Payne will travel cross country from Indiana and 2017 KOTW Champion Davey Hamilton Jr. hails from Boise, ID

All these drivers and many more and many will be eying the 10-year-old track record of 13.268 set by Nick Haywood. At press time, it was still unclear if Haywood would be in attendance.
