Warf Takes Royal Purple King of the Wing Northwest Championship Three Nights, Two Tracks, Two Track Records, Three Different Winners, and Three Championships

September 17, 2017 - Meridian, Idaho – Thirty-two drivers competed in the Northwest tour of the Royal Purple King of the Wing National Sprintcar Series over the weekend. The series kicked off Thursday night at Magic Valley Speedway in Twin Falls, Idaho. Despite Mother Nature's attempts to ruin the night no scheduled races were cancelled. The three races are not only points races for the Royal Purple King of the Wing Series but the Orchex Western Sprintcar Series and the Royal Purple NSRA Series.

In the 40-lap feature event Bryan Warf would take the lead from his outside front row starting position on the drop of the green flag. The Meridian chauffeur would keep the Pat Russell owned entry in front of the rest of the field for the entire distance. It would be the second victory of the current campaign against the Royal Purple NSRA Winged Sprintcars and is his first career King of The Wing triumph.

Johnny Giesler, also from Meridian, was second while grabbing third would be Matt Hein, out of Roseburg, Oregon. The balance of the top five consisted of fourth finishing Eric Humprhies, from Chowchilla, California, and Langley, British Columbia's Aaron Willison, making an appearance in the Rod and Gord Rendle machine, in fifth.

Jason Conn, making the extremely long tow from Prince George, British Columbia, was quickest in time trials setting a new track record for the 3/8th mile track. Heat race winners were Quesnel, British Columbia veteran Ron Larson, Meridian native Colton Nelson, Salt Lake City, Utah's Kyle Bergener, and Bryan Warf. Kyle Alberding, from Winston, Oregon and racing for car owner Art Holte, won the consolation feature.

The series moved about 120 miles Northwest to Meridian Speedway for a double header at the famed quarter mile oval in Downtown Meridian, Idaho.

Chowchilla, California driver Eric Humphries would start on the front row and was the leader on the opening lap. He would remain in the position the entire way as he went on to win his first race of the season with both the Royal Purple NSRA Winged Sprintcars and King Of The Wings. It also is the first career King Of The Wing for the Central Valley native.

Meridian's Bryan Warf was a respectable second followed by fellow Meridian pilot Johnny Geisler, in third. The rest of the top five would be made up of fourth finishing Matt Hein, out of Roseburg, Oregon, and Tristen Spiers, out of Adrian, Oregon and racing for Joey and Sarah Moore, in fifth.

Matt Hein was the quickest in qualifying in the early stages of the night. Heat race winners were Austin Carter of Clovis, California, Johnny Giesler, Hein, and Carmichal, California's Tom Baker. Ryan Orchard, from Sidney, British Columbia, was the victor in the consolation feature.

Three championships were decided going into the weekend. By the start of Saturday night action both Royal Purple NSRA Champion were decided. Brian Orchard collected Sportsman Sprintcar champion honors, while Surry, British Columbia, Canada's Aaron Willison claimed the overall NSRA tour championship.

After Thursday and Friday's races the Royal Purple King of the Wing Northwest Championship had three driver separated by just 2 points. Bryan Warf lead Johnny Giesler by 1 and Matt Hein by 2.

A blistering fast track greeted the Royal Purple King of the Wing National Sprintcar Series competitors Saturday. During qualifying a whopping five drivers turned times faster than Andy Alberding's seven-year-old track record. When the thunder of race engines faded Meridian, Idaho native Johnny Giesler stood atop the Pepsi-Cola scoreboard with a lap time of 11.034 seconds.

The Pink Lady Classic concluded with a fifty lap Saturday night slugfest. With Royal Purple King of the Wing National Sprintcar Series championship points on the line, and titles to be determined in the Orchex Western Sprintcar Series and the Royal Purple Northwest Sprintcar Racing Association, all 24 drivers brought a razor focus to the green flag.

On the break, pole sitter Ryan Burdett roared to the top spot in his FRB Welding machine. On the move early was Roseburg, Oregon's Matt Hein, who sliced from his sixth-place starting spot to third on the first lap. It took Hein only four more laps to take over second place and work to close on Burdett.

Lapped traffic was heavy early, but Burdett navigated it easily to maintain a one second advantage over Hein on lap ten. But Hein's rapid pace took its toll, and his attention soon turned to third place runner Johnny Giesler, who worked the high line in his Bardahl, Spiers Construction entry. Lapped traffic helped Hein hold Meridian, Idaho native Giesler at bay, and allowed the pair to catch Burdett at the race's halfway mark.

As soon as Giesler caught sight of the leader and he rocketed past Hein to second. With Burdett in his sights Giesler laid down lightning fast laps as he closed on the leader. But Giesler wasn't the only driver on the move, as suddenly Meridian, Idaho's Bryan Warf, tore free of the pack and started searching for a way past the runner up. Giesler picked Warf off on lapped traffic for eight laps, but Warf's Allan Marsh Travel Center, Rex Hutchinson Race Engines sprinter was too strong and he dove low to secure the second spot.

But Warf wasn't done, and with a dozen laps remaining he latched onto Burdett's tail tank. Warf tested low first, but West Jordan, Utah's Burdett held. Next Warf tried high, but Burdett shut the door as the battle wound its way through traffic. With nine circuits remaining the leaders hit open race track and Warf mounted his most furious challenge yet. Lap after lap Warf pushed his machine hard, and with five to go Warf drew even with Burdett. But lapped traffic stymied Warf's run, and he had to settle for second behind Burdett.

All fifty blistering laps flew by in just over 10 heart-pounding minutes.

Heat races were won by Ryan Orchard, Tom Baker, Kyle Bergener, and Colton Nelson. The 12-lap B-main win went to Casey Tillman.

With his 2nd place finish in Saturday night's feature Bryan Warf was crowned the Royal Purple King of the Wing National Sprintcar Series North West Championship.
